


## WHAT ARE THEY?

Dental implants help replace missing teeth. Unlike dentures, dental implants are not removable and give you much more freedom in your day to day life.

A dental implant looks similar to a screw. It is made of titanium and is placed into the jaw where the roots of the missing tooth used to be. A crown, also known as an artificial tooth, is then placed on top. This is the part you can actually see!



## FAQ

#### 1. Does it hurt?

The area in question will be numbed with local anesthesia. There may be some slight discomfort, but it's nothing to worry about and the procedure is relatively painless. Remember, we're here to help you all the way! Some patients experience slight discomfort after receiving their implants, but the feeling tends to fade after 1 to 2 days.

#### 2. How do I take care of my implants?

Brushing your teeth and flossing twice daily is super important! A soft-bristle toothbrush is also a good idea.

## DIGITALLY GUIDED IMPLANTS EXPLAINED

Here at Dentistry on Solent, we strive to give you the best possible treatment. So, we started to use a digital implant system.

During a conventional dental implant procedure, the gum is opened up, the implant placed and the gum is then sealed. But now, with computer-guided digital implant surgery, the implant is carefully placed through the gum without having to raise the gingival flap.

For the patient this means:

- Decreased time spent in surgery with minimal risk
- Minimal bleeding, if any, with no sutures
- Less trauma to the area for speedier post-surgical recovery
